To provide students with the taste of quiz during this lockdown, KCCILHE Technical society organised a Quiz, TECHBUZZ 2.0.










First round of the Technical quiz was held on 05 June 2020. Duration of the quiz was 20 minutes & it was taken on Google Forms. There were 25


