The session began with lightening of lamp, followed by felicitation of our guest with a sapling as a token of welcome which was followed by a brief profile reading of the speaker. The Guest Lecture began from the Introduction of E-commerce. First the speaker explained the proper meaning of the topic. Afterwards he discussed the various types of e-commerce like B2B (Business to Business), B2C (Business to Customer), C2B (Customer to Business) and C2C (Customer to customer). 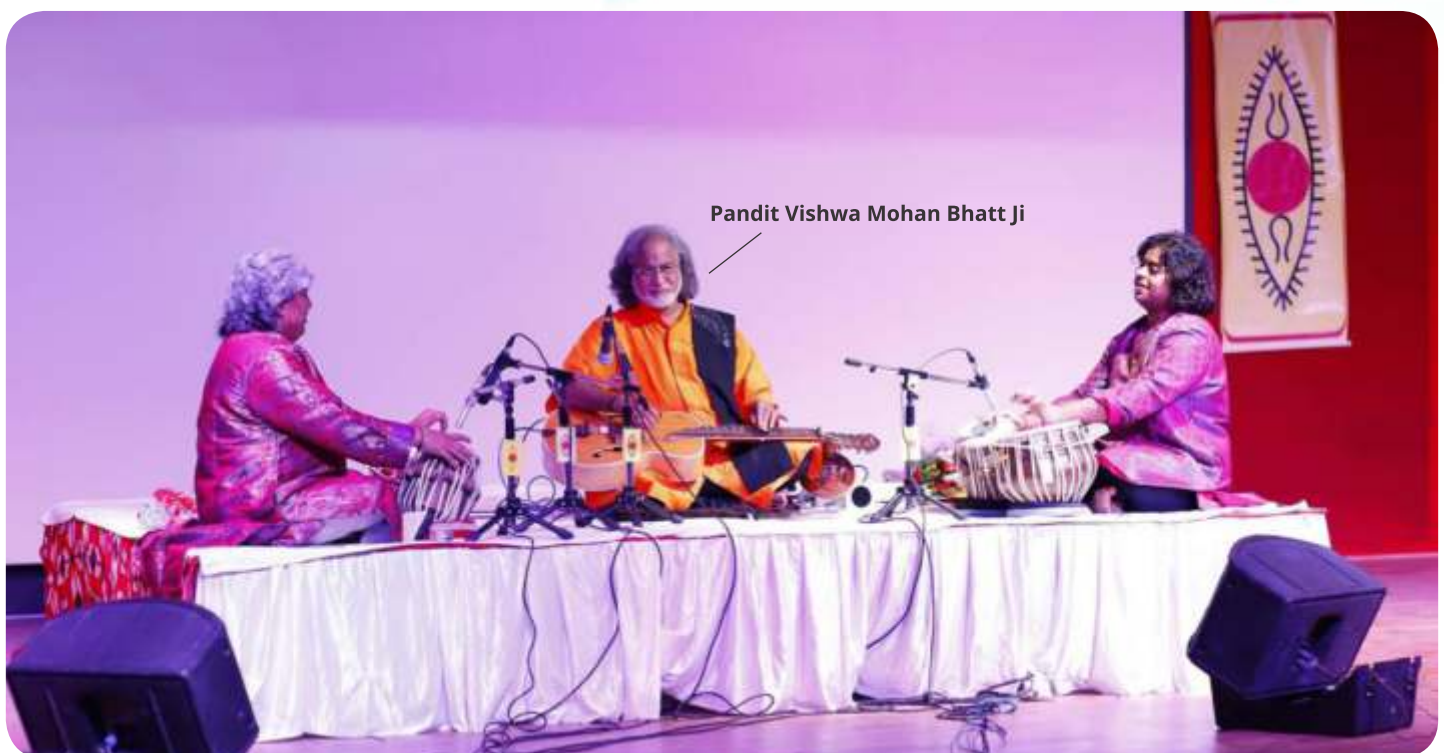


12<sup>th</sup> September, 2018

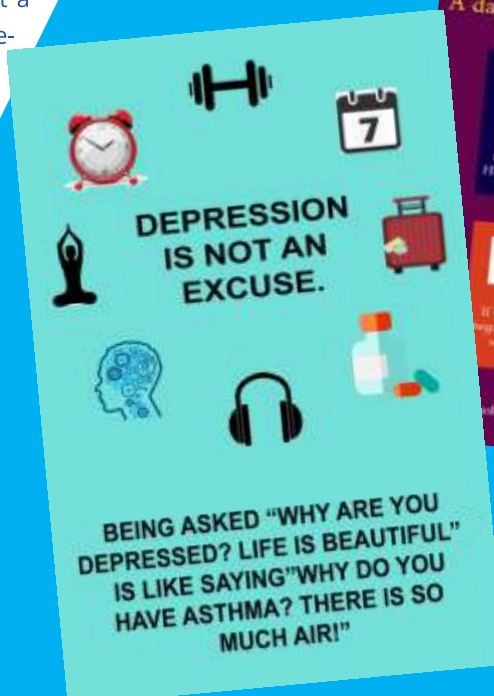


## Photoshop

## DAY 1: 17th December 2018

### Topic: Paradigm Shift and Transformation in Teaching Learning Process.

The session was divided in two phases from 11 AM-1 PM and 2 PM-3 PM, where the speaker talked about improvement in instruction models, use of technology and various activities to make learning process student-centered, interesting and activity oriented. He discussed that learning process should be planned and based on the science of active learning and motivate the students to develop a spirit of self study.

He explained how these recommendations will bring about a paradigm shift by equipping our students, teachers and educational institutions with the right competencies and capabilities.

## DAY 3: 19th December 2018

Speaker: Prof Anuj Bhatt

### Topic: Innovative Approaches in Teaching Learning Process.

The session was divided in two phases from 11 AM-1 PM and 2 PM-3 PM, where the speaker talked about the need of scaling up the educational efforts. Focus was on suggesting ways to increase interaction between Teaching Faculty and experts from different Industries which will eventually help in organizing joint research and development. Speaker also gave emphasis to motivate students to participate in workshops / seminars / conferences.



## **DAY 4: 20th December 2018**

**Speaker: Prof (Dr.) Pawan Gupta**

### **Topic: Teaching Pedagogies for Result Oriented Learning.**

The session was divided in two phases from 11 AM-1 PM and 2 PM-3 PM, where the speaker threw light on effective teaching tools that a teacher should equip with to deliver an effective lecture. He explained, how excellent teachers set up routines for group-work, peer review, distributing papers, etc., to help reduce chaos and increase instructional time. There are also specific techniques for effective use of questions and encouraging discussions in large classrooms. In under-resourced classrooms, teachers need to be especially creative about how to use locally available materials, and how to connect lessons to observations of the social and natural environment. These approaches can, in fact, strengthen teaching even in well-resourced classrooms since teaching and learning materials are most beneficial when they are relevant to students' lives.

## **DAY 5: 21<sup>st</sup> December 2018**

**Speaker: Dr. Rachna Garg**

### **Topic: Innovative Approaches in Teaching Learning Process.**

The session was divided in two phases from 11 AM-1 PM and 2 PM-3 PM, where the speaker spoke about how one can use the latest technologies in delivering an impactful lecture & how one can take the help of tools to stimulate creativity and encourage creative contributions. Incorporating audio-visual materials like models, filmstrips, movies, pictures, infographics or other mind mapping and brain mapping tools to supplement textbooks during the sessions will help their imagination thrive and grow. The FDP concluded with the valedictory function where all the 25 participants were given participation certificate by the director of KCCILHE, Prof (Dr.) Pawan Gupta.
